# AFL OUTER EAST RGM

## 2020 Report - Aaron Bailey



2020, which was lost to the Covid-19 pandemic, has been a year unlike any other we have seen. It tested the resilience, sustainability and viability of our commission, competitions, and clubs. As the pandemic took hold and it became clear we may lose games or the season proper, the Outer East clubs and Commission made a collective decision to do everything within their power to get competitions started in 2020. Every avenue and solution were exhausted. However, the significant outbreak and lockdown that occurred in late June/July, despite the best efforts of everyone involved across the competition, saw no football or netball played for the first time since the world wars.

The response from our region, in particular our clubs, volunteers, and participants, highlighted the strength and solidarity of our football, netball community. In many ways, Covid brought our clubs and the region together, following the recent changes over the past few years. The saying, "never waste a crisis" has never been more applicable, with our community rallying together, led by our volunteers, to ensure every club returns in 2021.

Our focus moving into 2021 once the season was cancelled was two-fold, easing the burden on volunteers, as well as providing more offerings for clubs through their fees and affiliation. After what has been the most challenging year seen in community football, providing significant support to our clubs and easing the financial burden in 2021 was a priority. Providing relief for our clubs and participants allows us to move towards 2021 with excitement and anticipation about returning to competition in football and netball.

The significant reduction in debt, as well as the improved cash position of the commission, highlight what has been an outstanding financial result for the region and provides us with a fantastic platform of stability and strength moving into what is a vital year for our clubs and competitions. We thank all our sponsors and clubs for their ongoing support in what has been a challenging year. Pleasingly for the commission's viability long term, we were able to retain and/or extend all sponsors into 2021, as well as welcoming new partners in Rochford Wines, Pedders Suspension & Brakes, and Box Hill Institute.

Council and government financially supported clubs through rent relief and various grants, whilst the commission absorbed all club-related costs. Once it was clear no competitions would proceed in 2020, it was vital as an organisation that we were able to navigate financially through 2020, retaining all staff and maintaining our financial position of 2019. Importantly, we were able to ensure that clubs were supported, with no fees or charges passed on to clubs.

In assisting clubs through post-COVID recovery, significant club and player discounts will be provided in 2021. In a move designed to support clubs and participants across the Outer East region in returning post-COVID-19, Outer East will pass on savings of \$280,775 to participants and clubs in 2021. Senior Clubs, depending on their total teams, will see savings between \$5,000 and \$7,500, while Junior and standalone netball clubs will see savings of \$1,500 and \$2,000. Savings to clubs will be \$195,000, while the total amount saved by participants in 2021 will be \$85,000, which includes the removal of the football player levy for 2021. This removal has been achieved through AFL Victoria support and funding. A discount to the 2021 netball player levy will also be provided to all netball participants.

The Melbourne East Football Facility Strategy, the largest review undertaken in the region in relation to facilities, was released in 2020. This document, developed in conjunction with all leagues and councils in the East of Melbourne, will provide a long-term strategic framework for facility planning and development. A positive of 2020 has been the significant facility development across the region, including lighting upgrades, drainage and resurfacing upgrades and new pavilions. Cranbourne, Alexandra, Wandin, Berwick Springs, and Gembrook will all enter 2021 with new facilities.

AFL Outer East is thankful for the investments by council and government to upgrade facilities to be female friendly, inclusive and add available utilisation hours at grounds to accommodate existing and new participants.



# AFL OUTER EAST RGM

2021 provides new opportunities to grow our games and our region. Two new partnerships, media partner Gameface and TidyHQ, will see increased offerings for clubs in club administration and digital media. This will include introduction of full game stats for all senior football games, as well as match highlights for each game, a weekly footy/netball show, increased digital content for clubs, an online store for club orders and TidyHQ's online administration package. The content available to clubs through the vision now will provide a valuable tool to promote their club, sponsors, and community.

Thank you to all the volunteers across the region, in particular our presidents, for your support in navigating our way through COVID-19. I would like to pay special mention to Tony Mitchell and the AFL Outer East commission for their vision, leadership, and guidance in a challenging year. They continue to seek and explore ways to improve the region and support both myself and the Outer East staff in providing the best possible administration and management to our clubs and stakeholders.

The Outer East staff and commission should be commended on their tireless effort to achieve this goal, under real adversity.

The communication, collaboration, persistence and commitment to our clubs and community was outstanding and I am immensely proud of the work undertaken by our team in 2020. This was highlighted in our Return to Play Guidelines, which were as comprehensive and considered as any document of its type produced by sporting associations in the state. We speak often as a staff and commission of being Accountable, Approachable, Connected, Trusted and Supportive. In 2020, when they were truly tested, the staff and commissioners lived up to those values.

Season 2021, with the introduction of significant reductions in salary caps in senior football and better fee structures across all competitions, provides clubs with a more sustainable and accessible future. Engaging our participants, supporters, volunteers, and communities, ensuring as many people return to football and netball, will be our primary focus as we return to a Covid normal. Reengaging people not only to our clubs, but our communities, and ensuring all clubs survive long into the future, will underpin our decision making and planning moving forward.



# COMMISSION CHAIR

## 2020 Report - *Tony (Knobby) Mitchell*



After a non-season for 2020 in all grades of football and netball due to COVID-19, this past 12 months has been the most difficult from an administration point of view that I have been involved in.

During the early part of the season when assessing the potential delays and/or commencement of our season, we were focused and committed on getting some sort of season up, including modified to a shorter season with a reduced finals series, we really did not care. Our thought process was from a community point of view, and the mindset and wellbeing of our players, committee, parents, and spectators. We all needed something to get us through these difficult shut down times.

I know there were many comments on social media sites asking us to just call off the season and be done with it. We felt that whether the season went ahead or not, we tried our utmost to ensure players got the chance to interact at a minimum with their team at training and hopefully on game day.

During these difficult times, we choose to waiver the player registration fees and refund clubs for the amounts received prior to winding up the season. These funds were either credited to club accounts or clubs handed the money back to their players. We were extremely conscience of the financial strain on all clubs during these once-in-a-lifetime difficult times, and hopefully beyond 2021 we do not have to experience anything like this again.

Our sports are vital to all our close communities and townships involved, and we are committed to ensuring all our clubs prosper from 2021 and beyond. However, we need to continue to work together as partners within both our football and netball communities.

We might be in battle on the field/court, but we are one unit moving together and we help each other survive, keeping in mind we are only as strong as the weakest team/s.

On a sad note, from both mine and commission's perspective, we had a massive loss with Shane Smith passing away in December 2019. As we are all aware, Shane was a committed worker and great support for me as Deputy Chair and a long-time friend. For those that are not aware, we have named the Premier Division Best & Fairest Seniors award after Shane, something I know he would be honoured to receive.

The AFL Outer East will continue to grow as a competition with the encouragement of club development through increased junior teams, netball juniors and senior teams. We must ensure we are focused on the improvement of both the football and netball competitions, and that we give each club the opportunity in finding its own level and standard, within our proven divisional structure.

I wish to again acknowledge and thank the great work being undertaken by our office staff during these difficult times under the management of Aaron Bailey our Region General Manager, Danny Ryan as the league's Football Development Manager, Operations Manager Cameron Hutchison, Junior Football Operations Coordinator Andrew Gibbons, Accounts Administrator Sheryn Harbert, Director of Umpiring Scott Van Noordennen and Netball Operations Manager Greg Heinrich.

Our staff are truly committed and have proven their worth during these difficult times, with their continued support for our clubs within all facets of football and netball, inclusive of business models and committee development programs.

### ***Opinion***

### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR YEAR ENDED 31 OCTOBER 2020

#### 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These financial statements are a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012, for use by the members of the League and to fulfil the board's requirements to prepare financial statements.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012 and the following Accounting Standards:

No other applicable Accounting Standards, Australian Accounting Interpretations or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied. The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations. The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis.

The following significant accounting policies have been adopted in the preparation of these financial statements and consistently applied to all periods covered.

#### PROPERTY, PLANT & EQUIPMENT

Items of property, plant and equipment are carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment loss. The items have been assessed for current replacement cost in 2019, and as a result there has been no change in the values of the individual items. Subsequent costs are included in the asset's carrying amount or recognised as a separate asset, as appropriate, only when it is probable that future economic benefits associated with the item will flow to the association and the cost of the item can be measured reliably. All other repairs and maintenance are charged to the income and expenditure statement during the financial period in which they are incurred.

Gains and losses on disposal of an item of property, plant & equipment are determined by comparing the proceeds from disposal with the carrying amount, and are recognised net within other income in the income and expenditure statement.

#### CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC 2020

The League has been eligible to receive the Job-Keeper payments for staff, and this is likely to be continue through to the end of the program in March 2021. The League has received total government income support for the pandemic during the year of \$219,936, comprising cash boosts, grants and jobkeeper. This support has helped to mitigate the losses in income from operational areas.

### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR YEAR ENDED 31 OCTOBER 2020

#### DEPRECIATION

Depreciation is calculated on the depreciable amount of all fixed assets over their useful lives commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

The depreciation methods and rates used for each class of assets are as follows:

Computer Equipment – Diminishing value method 33%.

Furniture & Fittings – Diminishing value method 7.5% to 20%.

Leasehold Improvements – Diminishing value method 20%.

Motor Vehicles – Diminishing value method 25%

Depreciation methods, useful lives and residual values are reviewed at each financial year end and adjusted if appropriate.

#### INVENTORIES

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. The cost is based on the first in, first out principle and includes expenditure incurred in acquiring the inventories and other costs associated with bringing them to their existing location and condition. Net realisable value is the estimated selling price in the ordinary course of business, less the estimated selling expenses. The increase in the value of inventory in 2020 represents major items of stock held over to the 2021 season due to the impact of covid-19.

#### LEASES

Operating leases do not transfer substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to ownership of an asset.

Payments made under an operating lease are recognised in the expenditure statement on a straight line basis over the term of the lease. The leased assets are not recognised in the balance sheet of the association.

#### EMPLOYEE ENTITLEMENTS

Provision is made for the association's liability for Employee Entitlements arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. Employee Entitlements that are expected to be settled within one year have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled, plus related on-costs. Annual leave has been assessed in accordance with the provisions of AASB 119 however, no change in classification between current and non-current is considered necessary.

#### INCOME TAX

The League has been granted an income tax exemption by the Australian Taxation Office.

#### GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST), except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of the expense. Receivables and payables are stated with amount of GST included. The net amount of GST recoverable or payable to the Australian Taxation Office is included as a current asset or liability in the balance sheet.



### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR YEAR ENDED 31 OCTOBER 2020

#### REVENUE RECOGNITION

##### Property Division Sales

Property Division Sales represent revenue earned from the sale of products to member clubs. Revenue is recorded when the goods are despatched.

##### Interest Income

Interest Income is recognised as it accrues.

##### Management Fees

Management Fees represent revenue earned from charges to member clubs used to fund the provision of services (including but not limited to umpires).

##### Asset Sales

The profit or loss on disposal of assets is included as revenue of the association. Such profit or loss on disposal of assets is brought to account at the date an unconditional contract of sale is signed.

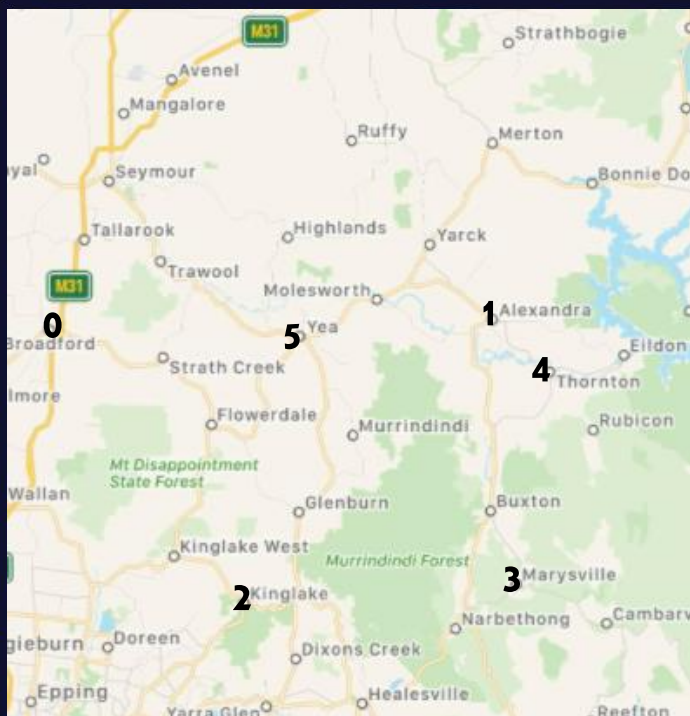

We now look forward to working with Glenn Carter and the GameFace team to further enhance our media offerings to our clubs and participants alike.

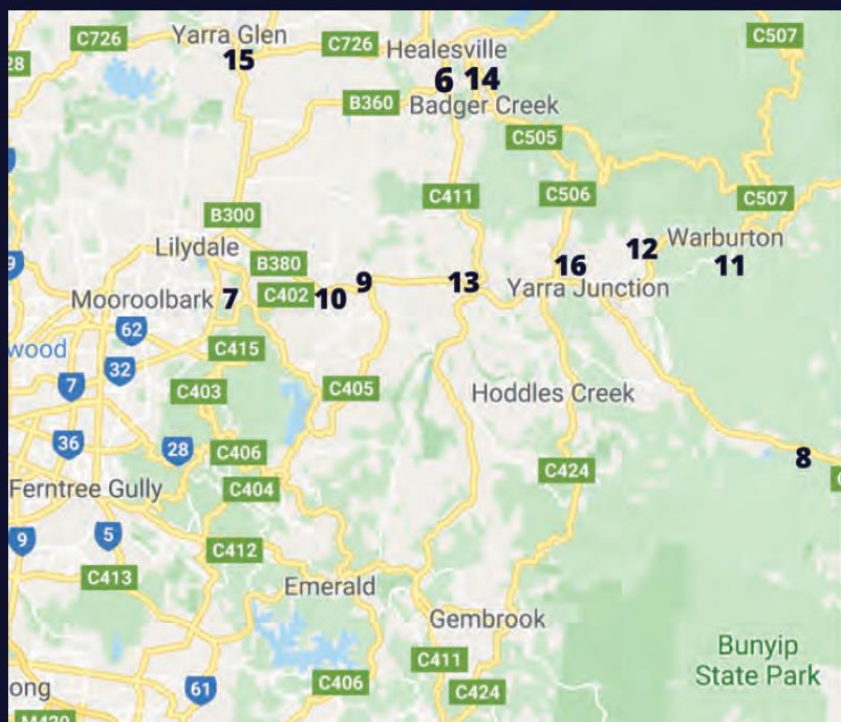

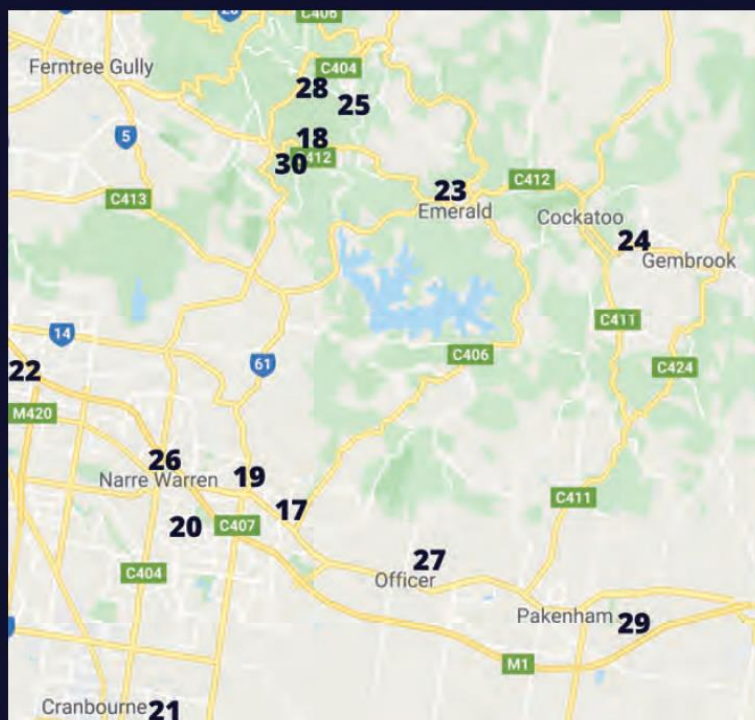
