## **TAC CLUB REWARDS FUNDING**

The TAC Club Rewards Program is back for 2024, giving grassroots football and netball clubs the opportunity to earn a share in \$600,000 in funding by participating in the mission to eliminate deaths and serious injuries on our roads.

As apart of the program, our clubs can take part and earn up to \$10,000 in funding by promoting road safety in their community.

This year the focus is on tackling speeding.
