

- Intermediate practical workshop, assessment

- All accreditations require pre-requisite of prior accreditation + Rules of Netball exam
- Must be updated every four years

Coaches in the Field

- Ideal for hosting during training session when coaches and athletes are in a learning environment.
- Requires court access and training equipment (balls, bibs, cones etc).

Accreditation Courses

- Development 4.5 hrs
 - 10 14 athletes (14y min.)
- Intermediate 8 hrs
 - Participants to bring 2 players each to assist with practical assessments (14y min.)
- Meeting/club rooms
- AV equipment
